

Casual Theatre Technician

Job Purpose:

To assist the Technical Manager, Theatre Technician and in setting up and running music gigs, theatre productions and events at The Drill and elsewhere as required.

To assist the Front of House & Bar Manager to deliver venue support on events including but not limited to, event setup and FOH Stewarding (both indoor and outdoor events)

Main responsibilities

To assist with the get-ins and get-outs of music gigs, theatre productions and events.

To assist with rigging and focussing lighting as well as operating basic lighting requirements.

To assist with setting up sound equipment and operating basic sound requirements

To work on stage as required (e.g. scene changes).

To assist with turn-arounds between shows and events

To assist with the preparation, fit-ups, operation and get-outs of outdoor and off-site events

To run simple events independently as agreed with the Technical Manager.

To help with the maintenance of technical equipment

To conform to with the Health and Safety requirements relevant to the post. The position involves working at height.

To provide FOH support as directed by the Front of House & Bar Manager and Venue Supervisors as required.

To set up spaces for events and activities around The Drill and elsewhere as required.

To assist other members of The Drill team as required.

To be responsible for the safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children wherever applicable within the role.

N.B. This is not a complete statement of all duties and responsibilities of this post. The postholder may be required to carry out other lawful and reasonable duties as directed by a supervising manager.

Essential Criteria

To have a solid knowledge of theatre and event lighting and sound.

To understand the importance of Health and Safety in Technical Theatre and to always implement best practice

Desirable Criteria

Knowledge of AV, computing, and stage effects.
